Class C Operator Training



Class C Operators are defined as "individuals who are the first line of response to events indicating UST emergency conditions, including but not limited to, taking appropriate action in response to emergencies or alarms caused by spills or releases from an UST system."

In the Event of a Release the Operator Should:

- > Stop and Contain the Release
- > Ensure that the release poses no immediate threat to human health and safety by removing explosive vapors and fire hazards (if possible)
- Call your local fire department or emergency contact
- Report spill as required by implementing agency
